Answer three questions.

- 1 Describe the selection process for the jury. Assess how far this process can ensure that those selected as jurors can fulfil their role without bias. [25]
- 2 Explain how Equity developed to solve problems caused by the common law. Assess the extent to which it has been successful in solving these problems. [25]
- 3 Explain the rights granted to citizens by the Human Rights Act 1998. Assess the extent to which this Act has been successful in protecting human rights. [25]
- 4 Describe how a defendant found guilty of a criminal offence in the Magistrates' court might appeal against conviction or sentence. Discuss the factors a defendant might consider when making any appeal. [25]
- 5 Explain the law that governs the treatment of individuals in custody at a police station. Assess whether the law is adequate to protect individuals in these circumstances. [25]
- **6** Explain the role of solicitors and their rights of advocacy. Assess the extent to which changes to their role and rights of advocacy have improved the service they can offer. [25]
