Designs should initially be developed on paper and candidates may choose to produce three-dimensional outcomes. In such cases the work must be photographically or digitally recorded.

Supporting studies must be taken into the examination room and **must** be submitted for external assessment together with the final examination work. The submission will be assessed as a whole.

At the end of the examination, place the final examination piece on top of the supporting studies and fasten all your work together in the top left-hand corner.

All questions in this paper carry equal marks.

- 1 Design a logo for a kitchen utensils company. The name of the company, **KITCHCO**, must be included in your design. In addition show how the logo will look on a shop front **and** on a sales assistant's apron.
- **2 Either (a)** Design a cover for a book called **Time Travel**. You should include the front, spine and back of the book. Invent the author's name or use your own.
  - **Or (b)** Use the following statement as a stimulus for a design brief of your choice. You may produce your work in any appropriate medium.

Remember your past and you will have a future.

- 3 Create a repeat pattern based on **two or more** tools or items such as spanners, electric drills, screws and nuts & bolts.
- 4 For a music and dance production called Jazz in the Jungle,
  - **Either** (a) Design a costume, mask or headdress for a performer.
  - **Or (b)** Design a poster for the production.
- 5 Design a circular mural for the foyer of a museum, celebrating 100 years of aviation. Show how your design will look in situ.
- **6** Design a kinetic sculpture for the courtyard of a Science and Technology College. Show how the sculpture will look from **two** different viewpoints.
